### **SPITTING FEATHERS VILLAGE MEETING ON MAY 25th**

At a well attended meeting, Chairman Will Owen gave a comprehensive briefing on the history of the planning application and the main arguments that they would raise at the upcoming planning committee meeting, namely highways issues, noise from the fans and the landscape and visual impact issues raised. Vice Chair Denise Broomfield covered the legal aspects of the case and the alternative approaches which were available; to totally oppose the permission or to oppose but be prepared to suggest planning conditions should the planning committee be minded to grant permission. The latter plan was chosen from a vote. Councilor Fleur de The-Philippe kindly attended and answered many questions.

The application is likely to be heard in County Hall at Trowbridge, on June 28th at 3:00 pm.
